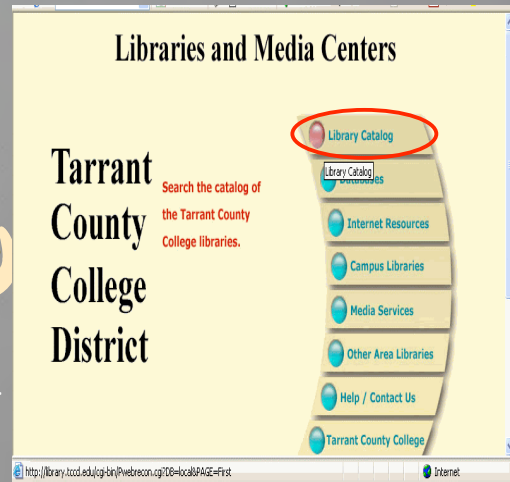
Finding library resources

- **Note:** If you are not at a TCC computer, you must know your [WebAdvisor user ID and password](#) to access e-books and periodical databases.

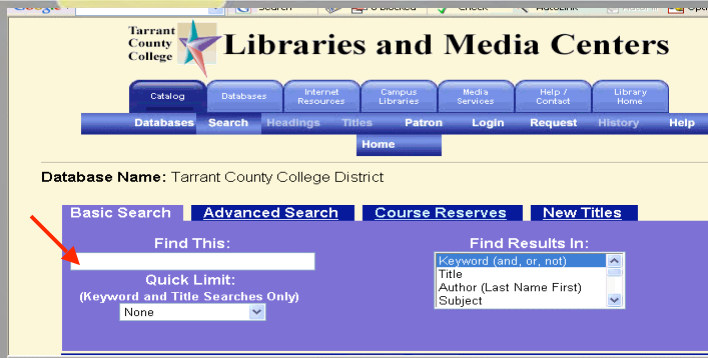
Finding Electronic Books



- Click on Library Catalog.



Catalog search page



- Enter your search term into the "Find This" Search Box. Enclose phrases in quote marks such as "child abuse" or use a single word such as college.
- Then type the words **and netlibrary** after your keyword or phrase.

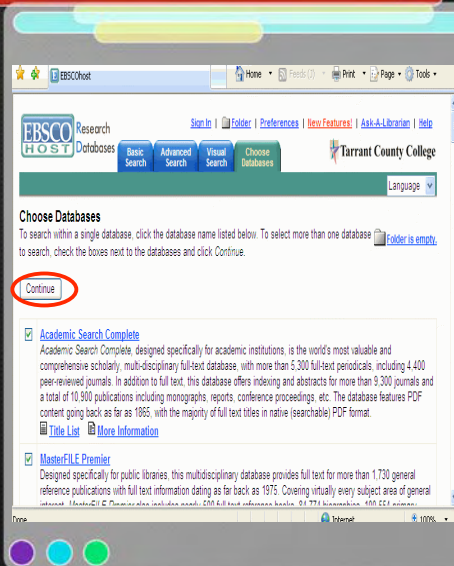

Database Main Page



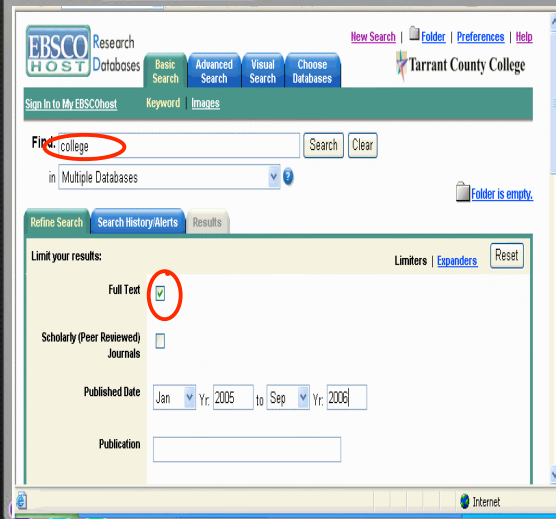
- Choose Librarian Recommended Database Collections to search multiple subject areas. Example: Click on EBSCOhost

General Database Search



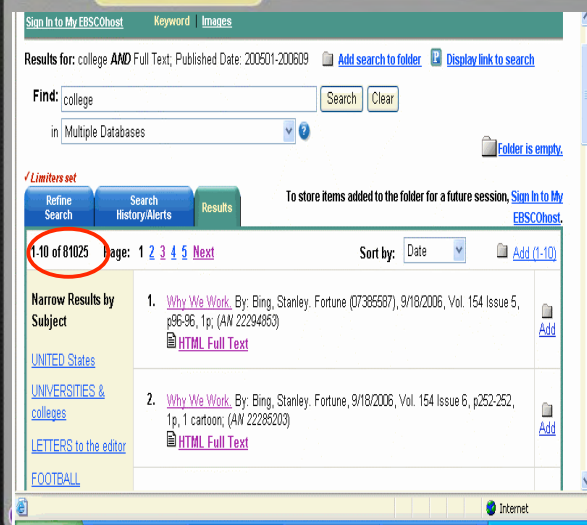
- Click on Continue.

- Type in a keyword. Example: **college**
- Choose limiters such as **full text**, **published date**, etc.
- Scroll down the page to see additional limiters.

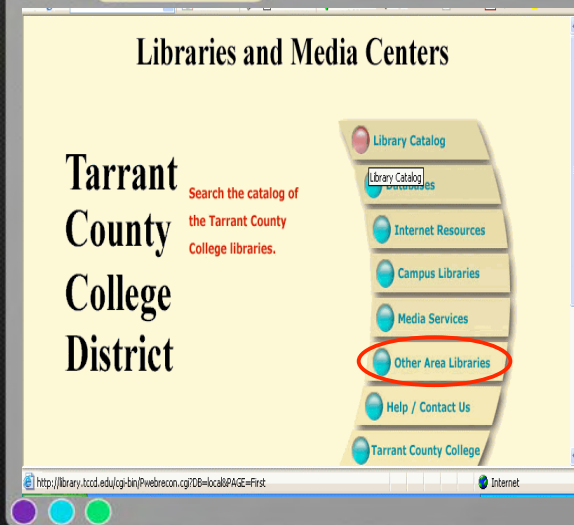
